Thumb Controller

Allowing greater maneuverability and comfort, soldiers can now rotate the turret/O-GPK and the weapon simultaneously without having to remove the gunner's hand from the weapon. The thumb controller attaches to the weapon, on left side of the grip, so that it can be easily used during firing.

The thumb controller is easily installed and removed on the M2 and MK19 weapons. It is fully interchangeable with magnetically

mounted joysticks currently in service with over 30,000 of the U.S. Army's GPK and O-GPK. Therefore, the thumb controller is suitable for use with Up-Armored HMMWVs, MRAPs, and other vehicles equipped with the BPMTU. Adaptations of this thumb controller for other weapons are in process.

The thumb controller operates in the same manner as the standard joystick. Both provide variable slew rate with rotational speeds up to 6 RPM.



The thumb controller can mount on the M2 or MK19.
